1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Amendment Regulations 2000 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on gazettal.

3 Amendment of *Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Regulations 1998*

Schedule 1 amends the *Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Regulations 1998*.

Schedule 1 Amendments

(regulation 3)

[1] Regulation 3, after definition of *Industry Act*

insert

quota year means:

- (a) for high quality beef exports to the European Union — 1 July to 30 June;
- (b) for lamb exports to the United States of America — 22 July to 21 July;
- (c) for sheepmeat and goatmeat exports to the European Union — 1 January to 31 December.

[2] After regulation 3

insert

3A Quota fees

- (1) For paragraph 28 (3) (b) of the Act, the fee payable by the holder of a quota on variation of the quota is 0.8 cents for each additional kilogram of quota entitlement allocated to the licensee in the quota year.
