1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Amendment Regulations 2002 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

3 Amendment of *Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Regulations 1998*

Schedule 1 amends the *Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Regulations 1998*.

Schedule 1 Amendment

(regulation 3)

[1] Regulation 3, definition of *quota year*

substitute

quota year means:

- (a) for sheepmeat and goatmeat exports to the European Union — 1 January to 31 December; or
- (b) for high quality beef exports to the European Union — 1 July to 30 June; or
- (c) for beef exports to the United States of America — 1 January to 31 December.
