


**GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 2000 No. 26**

**THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY)**  
**(AMENDMENT No. 2) ORDER 2000**

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of its powers under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control)(Guernsey) Law 1946, hereby orders: -

1. In Schedule 1 to The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order 1990, (a), as amended (b) entry number 5 shall be repealed.
2. This Order may be cited as The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2000, and shall come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2001.

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**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Amendment Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order removes marine anti-fouling paint from Schedule 1 to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order 1990. That Schedule lists goods, which may not be imported from the UK without a licence. Controls on the importation of such paint are now contained in The Control of Poisonous Substances Regulations, 1995.
