**REGULATION OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE
NUMBER 47/Permentan/OT.140/4/2013**

**CONCERNING
IMPORT RECOMMENDATION OF HORTICULTURE PRODUCTS
BY THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY
MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE,**

Considering:

- a. that in the framework of importation of horticulture products, Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture Number 60/Permentan/OT.140/9/2012 had been established;
- b. that in relation to the above and to provide fluency, service assurance in issuing import recommendation of horticulture products and protection for horticulture farmers, there is a need to review Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture Number 60/Permentan/OT.140/9/2012;

In View of:

DECIDES:

To Stipulate: REGULATION OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE CONCERNING IMPORT RECOMMENDATION OF HORTICULTURE PRODUCTS

CHAPTER I

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1

In this Regulation what is referred to as:

1. Import of Horticulture Product is a series of import activities of horticulture products from oversea into the custom territory of the Republic of Indonesia.
2. Entry Point is a sea port or an airport that has been specified by the Minister as entry point.
3. Horticulture Product is all products from fresh or processed horticulture plants.
4. Import Recommendation of Horticulture Products hereinafter referred to as RIPH is a Letter which is issued by the Minister of Agriculture or appointed officials and is a requirement for the issuance of Import Recommendation.
5. Horticulture Business is all activities to produce and/or to provide service related to horticulture.
6. Producer Importer of Horticulture Products, hereinafter referred to as Producer Importer of HP is an industrial company that uses Horticulture Products as raw or auxilliary materials in its own production process and does not trade or transfer the product to other party.

7. Registered Importer of Horticulture Products, hereinafter referred to as Registered Importer of HP is a company which import Horticulture Products for business by trading and/or transferring it to other party.
8. Director General is the Director General of Agricultural Processing and Marketing, Ministry of Agriculture.

Article 2

This Regulation is intended as the legal basis of RIPH issuance which is a requirement for issuing Import Approval.

Article 3

This Regulation is intended to:

- a. improve the effectiveness and efficiency of managing the import of horticulture products; and
- b. provide assurance in issuing the RIPH.

CHAPTER II

REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES FOR ISSUING IMPORT RECOMMENDATION OF HORTICULTURE PRODUCTS

Part One

General

Article 4

- (1) Import of Horticulture Products is performed by the company after receiving import approval from the Minister of Trade or the appointed official.
- (2) Import approval as intended in paragraph (1) is issued after receiving the RIPH from the Minister of Agriculture.

Article 5

- (1) Implementation of RIPH issuance as intended in Article 4 paragraph (2) is delegated to the Director General on behalf of the Minister of Agriculture.
- (2) RIPH as intended in paragraph (1) is issued in the form of letter according to format-1, format-2, format-3 and/or format-4 as included in Appendix I which is an integral part of this Regulation.
- (3) RIPH shall contain at least:
 - a. RIPH number;
 - b. Company name and address;
 - c. Name and address of the President Director of the company;

- d. Number and date of the application;
- e. Product name;
- f. Tariff post/HS of the Horticulture Product;
- g. Volume;
- h. Time of entry;
- i. Industry location (for industrial materials);
- j. Country of origin; and
- k. Point of entry.

Article 6

- (1) Horticulture products that can be assigned RIPH comprise of fresh horticulture products for consumption, fresh products for industrial raw materials, processed products for industrial raw materials, and processed products for consumption, as included in Appendix II which is an integral part of this Regulation.
- (2) Horticulture Products as intended in paragraph (1) for food consumption must comply with food safety which is regulated by a separate Regulation.
- (3) Horticulture Products can be imported for the first time into the territory of the Republic of Indonesia after an Import Risk Analysis has been conducted according to the quarantine regulation procedures.

Part Two

Issuance Requirements for Import Recommendation of Horticulture Products

Article 7

- (1) The RIPH is issued with the following administrative requirements:
 - a. Fresh Horticulture Products for consumption includes:
 - Copy of the Registered Importer of HP status from the Ministry of Trade.
 - Copy of the General Importer Identification Number (API-U).
 - A statement stating that the importer will not import horticulture products which has exceeded 6 (six) months after the time of harvest.
 - b. Fresh and processed Horticulture Products for industrial raw materials include:
 - Technical consideration letter from the Ministry of Industry.
 - Copy of the Importer Producer Identification Number (API-P).
 - c. Processed Horticulture Products for consumption include:
 - Copy of the Registered Importer of HP status from the Ministry of Trade;
 - Copy of import approval letter from the Agency of Drug and Food Control.

- Copy of the General Importer Identification Number (API-U).
- (2) Issuance of RIPH for consumable fresh produce, in addition to meeting the administration requirements as intended in paragraph (1) item a, must be completed with the following technical requirements:
- a. land/plantation registration information or GAP certificate;
 - b. packing house registration which is issued by authorized agency from the country of origin;
 - c. have storage and distribution facilities for horticulture products which is in accordance with the product type and character.
- (3) Technical requirements as intended in paragraph (2) item a and b are translated into Bahasa Indonesia.

Part Three

Issuance Procedures for Import Recommendation of Horticulture Products

Article 8

- (1) Issuance of RIPH is conducted based on letter from the Minister of Trade or appointed official by completing the requirements as intended in Article 7.
- (2) The letter as intended in paragraph (1) has to at least include information on:
- a. Product name;
 - b. Tariff post/HS of the Horticulture Products;
 - c. Volume;
 - d. Time of entry;
 - e. Country of origin;
 - f. Point of entry.
- (3) The letter as intended in paragraph (2) for fresh and/or processed horticulture products as industrial raw materials has to include location information of the industry.

Article 9

- (1) Submission of application to obtain RIPH can only be done electronically online through the specified web portal.
- (2) The portal web as intended in paragraph (1) is a web-based application system that was developed for RIPH issuance service.

Article 10

- (1) The Director General, after receiving the letter from the Minister of Trade or the appointed official as intended in Article 8 paragraph (1), will finish checking the

completeness of the RIPH requirements no later than 7 (seven) working days as intended in Article 7.

- (2) If the inspected documents is declared complete, the RIPH is issued.
- (3) If the inspected documents is declared incomplete, the documents will be returned.

Article 11

- (1) The RIPH is issued twice within a year which is valid for the period from January to June and from July to December.
- (2) Issuance of RIPH as intended in paragraph (1) for the period from January to June will be issued at the end of December of the previous year at the latest.
- (3) Issuance of RIPH as intended in paragraph (1) for the period from July to December will be issued at the end of June of the current year at the latest.
- (4) Issuance of RIPH as intended in paragraph (1) for fresh horticulture products for industrial materials, processed products for industrial raw materials, and processed products for consumption is issued once in a period for 1 (one) company.

Article 12

- (1) In managing the RIPH policy, the Director General is assisted by the RIPH team.
- (2) RIPH team members as intended in paragraph (1) come from representative elements of the Coordinating Ministry for Economic Affairs, the Ministry of Industry, the National Development Planning Agency, the Central Agency of Statistics, the Agency of Drug and Food Control, and the required relevant agency.
- (3) Formation of the membership structure and duties of the RIPH team as intended in paragraph (1) is determined by a Ministerial Decree.

CHAPTER III

CLOSING PROVISIONS

Article 13

In the case of *force majeure* which resulted in the online system not functioning, application for RIPH can be submitted manually.

Article 14

This regulation does not apply to luggage of aircraft or ship passengers, as well as state border crossers with the intention for self consumption and an amount that is no more than 10 (ten) kilograms per person.

Article 15

With the enactment of this Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture, hence the Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture Number 60/Permentan/OT.140/9/2012 concerning Import Recommendation of Horticulture Products is revoked and declared invalid.

Article 16

This Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture shall come into effect on the date of its promulgation.

For public cognizance, ordering the promulgation of this Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture by including it in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia.
