

**S.I. No. 526 of 2002**

**European Communities (Pesticide Residues) (Fruit and Vegetables)  
(Amendment) Regulations, 2002**

I, Joe Walsh, Minister for Agriculture, Food and Rural Development, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3 of the European Communities Act, 1972 (No. 27 of 1972), and for the purpose of giving effect to Council Directive 76/895/EEC of 23 November 1976<sup>1</sup>, as amended by Commission Directive 80/428/EEC of 28 March 1980<sup>2</sup>, Council Directive 81/36/EEC of 9 February 1981<sup>3</sup>, Council Directive 85/528/EEC of 19 July 1982<sup>4</sup>, Council Directive 88/298/EEC of 16 May 1988<sup>5</sup>, Council Directive 89/186/EEC of 6 March 1989<sup>6</sup>, Council Directive 93/58/EEC of 29 June 1993<sup>7</sup>, Council Directive 96/32/EEC of 21 May 1996<sup>8</sup>, Council Directive 97/41/EC of 25 June 1997<sup>9</sup>, Commission Directive 2000/24/EC of 28 April 2000<sup>10</sup>, Commission Directive 2000/57/EC of 22 September 2000<sup>11</sup>, Commission Directive 2000/82/EC of 20 December 2000<sup>12</sup>, Commission Directive 2002/66/EC of 16 July 2002<sup>13</sup>, Commission Directive 2002/71/EC of 19 August 2002<sup>14</sup> and Commission Directive 2002/79/EC of 2 October 2002<sup>15</sup> hereby make the following Regulations:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Pesticide Residues) (Fruit and Vegetables) (Amendment) Regulations, 2002.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation in respect of Lindane on 1 December 2002, in respect of Dimethoate, Omethoate, Formothion, Oxydemeton-methyl, Demeton-S-methyl and Demeton-S-methylsulfone on 1 January 2003, in respect of Parathion on 1 May 2003 and in respect of bromopropylate on 1 August 2003.
2. Annex II of the European Communities (Pesticide Residues) (Fruit and Vegetables) Regulations, 1989 (S. I. No. 105 of 1989) is amended by the deletion of the entries relating to azinphos-ethyl, lindane, parathion, dimethoate, omethoate, formothion, oxydemeton-methyl, demeton-S-methyl, demeton-S-methylsulfone and bromopropylate.
