Animal Remedies Act 1993 (Section 2) Order 2005.

I, Mary Coughlan, Minister for Agriculture and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 2 of the Animal Remedies Act 1993 (No. 23 of 2003) and the Agriculture, Food and Forestry (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 2002 (S.I. No. 294 of 2002) (as adapted by the Agriculture, Food and Forestry (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2002 (S.I. No. 306 of 2002)), hereby order as follows-

1. This Order may be cited as the Animal Remedies Act 1993 (Section 2) Order 2005 and comes into operation on 17 November 2005.
2. The Animal Remedies Act 1993, the Control of Animal Remedies and Their Residues Regulations 1998 and the Animal Remedies Regulations 2005 apply to an animal, being-
 - (a) a domestic animal,
 - (b) a wild animal in captivity, and
 - (c) any other wild animal,

to which that Act does not, but for the making of this Order, apply by virtue of section 2(1) thereof.
