SEA BEACHES (REMOVAL OF SAND AND STONE) (JERSEY) LAW 1963¹

A LAW to regulate the removal of sand, stone, gravel, shingle, clay or loam

Commencement [[see endnotes](#)]

1 General prohibition

- (1) No person shall, except under and in accordance with the terms of a licence granted by the Minister for Planning and Environment –
 - (a) take or remove any sand, stone, gravel, shingle, clay or loam from any sea beach in Jersey;
 - (b) quarry, extract or remove any stone from any rocks forming part of the coasts of Jersey or from any rocks situated in the territorial sea adjacent to Jersey.²
- (2) Any licence under paragraph (1) may be granted subject to such conditions as the Minister for Planning and Environment may think fit to impose.

2 Saving

Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 1, the Minister for Economic Development may cause to be removed any sand, stone, gravel, shingle, clay or loam from within any harbour in Jersey, or the approaches thereto.

3 Penalties

Any person who acts in contravention of the provisions of this Law or who fails to comply with the conditions of any licence granted under Article 1, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £100 or, in the case of a second or subsequent conviction, to a fine not exceeding £100 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month or to both such fine and such imprisonment.

4 Citation

This Law may be cited as the Sea Beaches (Removal of Sand and Stone) (Jersey) Law 1963.
