SEA FISHERIES (FEES) (No. 2) (JERSEY) ORDER 2006

*Made**7th December 2006**Coming into force**1st January 2007*

THE MINISTER FOR PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENT, in pursuance of Regulation 7(5) of the Sea Fisheries (Licensing of Fishing Boats) (Jersey) Regulations 2003¹ and Regulation 3 of the Sea Fisheries (Underwater Fishing) (Jersey) Regulations 2003², orders as follows –

1 Charge for fishing boat licence

For the purposes of Regulation 7 of the Sea Fisheries (Licensing of Fishing Boats) (Jersey) Regulations 2003, the prescribed charge for the grant of a fishing boat licence is £83.50 (whether the licence is a class A licence or a class B licence).

2 Fees for scallop permits

For the purposes of Regulation 3 of the Sea Fisheries (Underwater Fishing) (Jersey) Regulations 2003, the prescribed fee for the grant of a permit to take scallops is –

- (a) if the permit is for the taking of scallops in unlimited quantities – £73.50;
or
- (b) if the permit is for the taking of a maximum of 24 scallops per day – £15.50.

3 Revocation

The Sea Fisheries (Fees) (Jersey) Order 2006³ is revoked.

4 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Sea Fisheries (Fees) (No. 2) (Jersey) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 1st January 2007.
