

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 42

THE WILDLIFE (CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT) ACT

(Cap. 376)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Wildlife (Conservation and Management) Act, the Minister for Tourism and Wildlife makes the following Regulations:—

**THE WILDLIFE (CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT)
(NATIONAL PARKS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2006**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wildlife (Conservation and Management) (National Parks) (Amendment) Regulations 2006 and shall come into operation on 1st July, 2006.

2. For the purposes of these Regulations, National Parks shall be categorized as follows:

Category "A"

Aberdares National Park
Amboseli National Park
Lake Nakuru National Park
Tsavo East National Park
Tsavo West National Park
Meru National Park
Nairobi National Park

Category "B"

Shimba Hills National Reserve
Arabuko Sokoke Forest Reserve
Ndere Island
Tana Primate Reserve
Kakamega Forest
All other Parks and Reserves

Category "C"

All Marine Parks and Reserves

Category "D"

Nairobi Safari Walk
Animal Orphanage
Impala Sanctuary

"Special"

Mt. Kenya

3. For the purposes of these Regulations, East African Citizens will be charged like Kenyan Citizens in all Parks and Reserves managed by Kenya Wildlife Service.

4. The Wildlife (Conservation and Management) (National Parks) Regulations are amended by deleting Parts II, III, IV and V of the Schedule thereto and inserting the following new Parts:

PART II—FEES FOR VEHICLES, BOATS AND AIR CRAFTS

1. Fees for Public Service Vehicles stationed in national parks and operating from hotels and lodges, camps and other places within the parks:

(a) For any vehicle with seating accommodation for not more than five passengers and commercial vehicles of less than two tonnes	30,000

(c) For any vehicle with seating accommodation for thirteen or more passengers and commercial vehicles of more than five tonnes	100,000
(d) For delivery vehicles (per entry)	500

2. Annual fees for commercial tourist boats stationed in marine reserves or operating from hotels and lodges, camps and other places within the parks and reserves

3. Fees for annual passes for private non-commercial boats to enter national parks and marine national parks and marine reserves

4. Fees for single entries of boats to national parks and marine reserves

3. There shall be payable a non-refundable reservation fee in respect of all "designated special camp sites" at the following rates:
- (a) Designated special camp site reservation fee per week or part thereof shall be seven thousand Five hundred Kenya shillings.
 - (b) Guided foot or horse safaris per person per day shall be one thousand shillings and five hundred shillings per half-day (4 hours) whether the person is alone or in a group, in addition to the park entry fees.
 - (c) Cancellation fee for special camp sites/all reserved sites is seven thousand five hundred Kenya Shillings.
4. For the purposes of these Regulations, a "daily fee" is a fee for one day (twenty-four hours or part thereof) of continuous stay within a specified national park.
5. "Student" is hereby defined as an individual from a recognized tertiary institution visiting the parks for purposes of learning about conservation through documented and organized arrangement with that institution. This excludes students on personally arranged holidays.
