

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 36 OF 1969

Proclamation of Monuments, Relics, Fauna and Flora

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by the provisions of section 8 of the Historical Monuments, Relics, Fauna and Flora Act, 1967, I,

Anthony C. Manyeli

Minister of Education hereby proclaim the following to be

Monuments

1. The rock painting site Ha Khotso, Maseru District.
2. The deposits of petrified wood on the top and slopes of Thaba-Tsoeu, Mphahlele District.
3. The fossilised and fossil footprint site of Maphutseng, Mphahlele District.
4. The fossil footprint site of Moyeni, Quthing District.
5. The nature reserve, archaeological site and cave house of Masitise-Seqhobo, Quthing District.
6. The top of Thaba Bosiu Fort, Maseru District, taking into due cognizance the full rights and traditions of the Basotho chiefs and people.
7. Major Bell's Tower at Hlotse, Leribe District.
8. The remains of the Fort at Fort Hartley, Quthing District.
9. The top of the Mount Moorosi Fortress, Quthing District.

Relics

1. All engravings and paintings on stone, commonly known as Bushman paintings/litsoantso tsa Baroa.
2. All fossil footprints and other markings, commonly known as dinosaur footprints/mehato ea liphofolo tsa khale e se-tseng matlapeng.
3. All fossil remains, whether of plant or animal origin/masapo kapa litlama le lifate tse fetohileng lejoe.
4. All archaeological deposits/lintho tse siiloeng ke batho ba mehla ea khale (Baroa le ba bileng Lesotho pele ho Baroa, le Basotho ba khale).

Protected Fauna

1. All antelopes and bucks/mefuta eohle ea linyamatsana, li-phofu, litsephe le matsa.
2. All baboons and monkeys/litsoene le likhabo.
3. All bushpigs and warthogs/inefuta eohle ea likolobe le likolobemoru.
4. All antbears, scaly anteaters and rats/mefuta eohle ea lithakali, khaha le seele.
5. All porcupines and hedgehogs/linoko le lihlong.
6. All springhares/tshipho le tshipjoane.
7. All otters and mongooses/mefuta ea liqibi, matoli ka bo-

samane le lehlahare.

8. All leguaans and varanas/mefuta ea lipolometsi le kang qamo le phathakalle.
9. All tortoises and terrapins/mefuta ea likhulu le khulu-ea-metsi.

The followings birds, including their eggs and nests:

10. All bearded vultures/seoli/lammergeyer.
11. All cranes, storks and herons/mefuta ea mehololi le meko-tatsie le kokolofitoc.
12. All hammerheads/masianoke.
13. All birds of prey/linonyana tsohle tse phelang ka nama tse kang ntsu, khajoane.
14. All egrets/maholosiane.
15. All secretary birds/mamolangoane.
16. All hoopoes and sunbirds/phupupu le taletale.

Protected Flora

1. All aloes, with particular reference to the aloe polyphylla, including its seeds and flowers/makhala 'ohle haholo-holo kharatsa, eata le peo le palesa tsa 'ona.
2. All bamboos/leqala.
3. All protea/sekila.
4. All wild olive trees/mohloare.
5. All cussonia/motsetse.
6. All rhus burchelli/mokhoamphiri.
7. All celastrus/sefeamaeba.
8. All leucosilo/phuku.
9. All heteromorpha/monkhoane.
10. All euleia/mohlakola.
11. All grewia/lesika.
12. All chilianthus/lelora.
13. All gladiolus specy.
