**SINDH WILDLIFE PROTECTION
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1998**

*An Ordinance to amend the Sindh Wildlife Protection
Ordinance, 1972*

No. S.Legis:1(4)/98, dated 20-3-1998.---The following Ordinance made by the Governor of Sindh is hereby published for general information:---

Preamble.---Whereas it is expedient to amend the Sindh Wildlife Protection Ordinance, 1972, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

And whereas the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:---

1. (1) **Short title and commencement.**---This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Wildlife Protection (Amendment) Ordinance, 1998.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sindh Wildlife Protection Ordinance, 1972, in section 17, after subsection (1), the following new subsection shall be inserted:--

"(1-A) Amendment of section 17 of Sindh Ordinance V of 1972.---Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1), whoever hunts (1) rabbit or (2) deer, hoodder or para. or (3) Sindh ibex or wildsheep in contravention of the provisions of this Ordinance shall respectively be punished (1) with a fine of one hundred thousand rupees or with imprisonment of three months, (2) with a fine of one hundred fifty thousand rupees or with imprisonment of six months or (3) with a fine of three hundred thousand rupees or with imprisonment of nine months."
