Notification of the Ministry of Public Health

(No. 218) B.E. 2544 (2001)

Re: Prescribed Cow's Milk to be Specific Controlled Food and Prescribed Qualities or Standards.

It deems appropriate to amend the notification of the Ministry of Public Health, Re: Prescribed cow's milk to be specific controlled food and prescribed qualities or standards and production processes, in order to keeping pace with cow's milk production in the country and to promote consumer protection measures.

By the virtue of provisions of Section 5 and 6 (1) (2) (4) (5) (6) and (7) of the Food Act B.E. 2522 (1979), in which contain provisions in relation to the restriction of Rights and Liberties of the Persons, in respect of which Section 29 and in conjunction with Section 35, Section 48 and Section 50 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permit by virtue of provisions of law; the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the notification as follows:

Clause 1. The expression in Clause 7(4) of the notification of the Ministry of Public Health No. 26 B.E. 2522 (1979), Re: Prescribed cow's milk to be specific controlled food and prescribed qualities or standards and production processes, dated 13th September B.E. 2522 (1979), shall be repealed. The following expression shall be used instead:

“(4) Milk solid non fat not less than 8.25% by weight and milk fat content not less than 3.2% by weight for fresh milk as stipulated in 2(1)”

Clause 2. This notification shall come into force as from the day following date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
