**The Game (Prohibited And Restricted Methods Of Hunting) Order.**

*(Section 31 (1) of the Act).*

1. THIS ORDER may be cited as the Game (Prohibited and Restricted Methods of Hunting) Order.

2. The use of bows and arrows or spears is prohibited throughout Uganda for the hunting of all scheduled animals except where the provisions of section 33 or section 37 of the Act apply.

3. The use of the weapons and missiles specified in the first column of the First Schedule to this Order is prohibited throughout Uganda for the hunting of the animals specified respectively in the second column of such Schedule.

4. The use of the weapons specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Order is prohibited throughout Uganda without the consent in writing of the Chief Game Warden for the hunting of the animals specified in the second column of such Schedule.

5. The use of the means specified in the first column of the Third Schedule to this Order is prohibited for the hunting of the animals specified in the second column of such Schedule in that part of Uganda specified in the third column of such Schedule.
