**Order, 2000**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in Regulation 9 of the Mines and Minerals (Environmental) Regulations, 1997 the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Mines and Minerals (Environmental) (Exemption) Order, 2000.

Title

2. The developer set out in the Schedule to this Order is exempted from the provisions of the Mines and Minerals (Environmental) Regulations for the period specified therein.

3. (1) The exemption granted under paragraph 2 is subject to the condition that the developer shall operate in accordance with an Environmental Management Plan developed and agreed upon between the developer and the Director.

Conditions  
of exemption

(2) Where the developer fails or neglects to comply with the condition set out in sub-paragraph (1) the provisions of the Mines and Minerals (Environmental) Regulations shall apply and be invoked by the Director.
