**1.** These By-laws may be cited as the Katete District Council  
(Establishment of Waste Disposal Sites) By-laws.

**2.** In these By-laws, unless the context otherwise requires-

Interpretation

"area" means the area under the jurisdiction of the Council;

"commercial wastes" means the wastes discharged from industrial  
activities;

"Council" means the Katete District Council;

"refuse" means wastes as defined under the Environmental Protection  
and Pollution Control Act, and includes hazardous wastes.

**3.** The places described in the Schedule hereto are hereby established  
as waste disposal sites for the area.

| <p><b>4.</b> Any person who disposes of commercial waste at a waste disposal site established by the Council under these By-laws shall pay to the Council a fee of fifty kwacha per kilogramme before disposal.</p>  | <p>Commercial waste disposal site levy</p> |
| <p><b>5.</b> Any person who disposes of wastes at any other place other than that established under these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction-</p> <p>(a) in the case of a first offence, to a fine not exceeding one thousand penalty units or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months, or to both;</p> <p>(b) in the case of a second offence, or subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding two hundred kwacha for every day during which the contravention continues.</p> | <p>Offences and penalties</p>              |
